

A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE INCORPORATION  
OF SURFACE WATER DRAINAGE PROVISIONS INTO  
ALL FUTURE DEVELOPMENT PROPOSALS FOR AREAS  
WHOSE SURFACE WATER RUN-OFF WOULD AFFECT  
THE KILIAN ADDITION DRAINAGE PROJECT OF  
HAVEN TOWNSHIP

- Whereas, the ground water problem in the Kilian and Wayside Additions of Haven Township has caused residents undue hardship, suffering, and thereby threatened their health and safety; and
- Whereas, these residents have pursuant to Minnesota Statute petitioned the Township Board of Haven to assist in finding a solution to these problems; and
- Whereas, the Township Board of Haven has in accordance with Minnesota Statute authorized a drainage improvement project designed to help remedy these problems; and
- Whereas, the Township Board of Haven has levied assessments against area residents to pay for the costs of said drainage improvement project; and
- Whereas, future development in this area seems inevitable causing additional surface water run-off, thereby resulting in over-capacitating and other problems for the above mentioned drainage system; and
- Whereas, the role of the Township Board of Haven in the area of future planning and zoning is primarily advisory;

NOW BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Haven Township Board recommends to the Sherburne County Board of Commissioners and to its planningbody, the Sherburne County Planning Advisory Commission, that whenever consideration is given to the approval of development plans to areas North, South, East, and West of the Wayside and Kilian Additions, such developments must include plans for the ponding and/or handling of surface water run-off in such manner as to prevent additional waters from being added to the drainage system herein described, thereby, preventing it from functioning in its original prescribed manner.
