

Sherburne County Turnback Agreement between Sherburne County and Haven Township

Whereas, Sherburne County Road 66 is presently a county road located wholly within Haven Township, Minnesota;

Whereas, County Road 66 was identified as a road that has local functional class per the Sherburne County Long-Range Transportation Plan (adopted December 11, 2007);


Whereas, Sherburne County is turning back CR66 to Haven Township pursuant to Minnesota Statute 163.11.

Therefore, the County of Sherburne and Haven Township agree as follows:

1. Sherburne County agrees to reconstruct CR66 as part of its construction schedule for 2016. This option is at a significantly higher cost than simply a “mill and overlay”. Because of the significant cost difference, Haven Township will not seek any additional fiscal reimbursement, maintenance or additional upgrade to the present CR66 upon completion of the reconstruct project. Specifically, Haven Township is exchanging the two-year maintenance after turn back for the reconstruction of CR66 pursuant Minn. Stat. 163.11, Subd. 5(a) and 5(b).
2. Sherburne County shall turn back CR66 to Haven Township upon the completion of:
 - A. The reconstruction of CR66 as stated in paragraph 1, above;
 - B. Compliance with the hearing and notice requirements of Minn. Stat. 163.11, Subd. 5(a);
 - C. The staking, mapping and notice for the marking of boundaries of highways pursuant to Minn. Stat. 160.14, Subd. 1 and 2 and filed with the County Recorder (satisfying Minn. Stat. 163.11, Subd. 5(a)(2));
 - D. Copies of all documentation on file with the Sherburne County Surveyor regarding CR66 shall be delivered to Haven Township; and
 - E. Copies of documentation on file with Sherburne County Public Works on the physical construct (i.e.: engineering studies, maps, utility permits, crosscuts, etc.) shall be delivered to Haven Township.


3. If, within the time lines set forth in Minn. Stat. 160.14, an abutting landowner serves notice, the County of Sherburne, through its County Attorney, shall take such action to establish the boundaries by stipulation or judicial determination. All costs associated with the establishment of boundaries shall be borne by the County of Sherburne.




