**RESOLUTION REGARDING A MINIMUM  
MAINTENANCE ROAD ON THE SOUTH  
END OF 45TH AVENUE**

**WHEREAS**, on March 15, 2004, the Sherburne County District Court issued its Order and Judgment determining that Haven Township owns a 66 foot wide roadway designated as 45th Avenue from 64th Street on the north end to the north shoreline of Long Lake on the south end.

**WHEREAS**, through the testimony at the trial and other information, the Haven Town Board has learned that the roadway has been used as an access for the public to Long Lake.

**WHEREAS**, the Haven Town Board finds that this portion of 45th Avenue is used only occasionally or intermittently.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:**

That the Haven Town Board hereby designates 45th Avenue from 64th Street going south to the north shore of Long Lake in a 66 foot wide roadway, with 33 feet lying each side of the section line between Sections 23 and 24, Township 35 North, Range 30 West, Sherburne County, Minnesota, as a Minimum Maintenance Road under Minnesota Statutes Section 160.095.

The designation of this Minimum Maintenance Road is effective on the erection of the signs required under Section 160.095.
